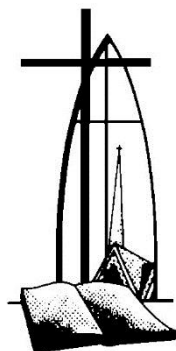
### **New Season at Calvary**
