REGARDING GODPARENTS FOR BAPTISM

Choosing the godfather and the godmother of a child is an important decision.

Their role is, with the parents, to present the child for baptism and to help the baptized to lead the Christian life in harmony with baptism and to fulfill faithfully the obligations inherent to it.

We would like to remind people of the following:

- according to the Code of Canon Law (the book containing the official laws of the Church)

a child can have: - a godfather AND a godmother

- or only one godfather

- or only one godmother

the child can not have two godfathers or two godmothers

- also, the godfather or the godmother of a child can not be changed later on

Conditions to be godfather or godmother:

1. be chosen by the parents (or the person who takes their place)

2. be suitable for this role and have the intention of fulfilling it

3. be at least sixteen years of age

4. be a Roman Catholic who has already been confirmed and has received the holy Eucharist

5. be leading a life of faith in harmony with the role to be undertaken

6. not be under a canonical penalty, whether lawfully imposed or declared

(for example, being "excommunicated", having officially renounced one's baptism)

7. not be either the father or the mother of the person to be baptized

N.B.: For a just reason, one may admit:

- as *godfather* or *godmother*, an Eastern non-Catholic

- as *witness to the baptism*, a person belonging to a non-Catholic ecclesial community

(i.e.: a Protestant, an Anglican) but only along with a Catholic godparent

A non-baptized person can not be either a godparent or a witness for a baptism

If you know a couple who is expecting a child or who has a child who is not yet baptized, PLEASE help us by giving them this information.
