ASH WEDNESDAY is this week *that* means the season of Lent begins. Please note that we will have **three Masses** that day... first one at **8:00 a.m.** the second Mass at **10:00am** with Saint Matthew CSS and the third Mass at **7:00 p.m.** We will distribute the ashes at all Masses. There will also be an Ash Wednesday celebration in our school.

N.B.: Ash Wednesday—as well as Good Friday—is a day of fast (eating less) and abstinence (refraining from eating meat) in Canada. The law of abstinence obliges those who are 14 and older. Fasting obliges those from 18 to 59 years of age. Parents and educators are reminded of their duty to introduce children gradually to the understanding and practice of penance. Adult example (as in many situations) will be the greatest influence in this matter.
