Ralph Martin Rally . . . Encounter Jesus

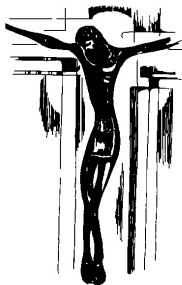

Faith in Action

The Supreme Court has given Parliament a year to enact a new law with respect to assisted suicide. But Parliament has the power to act right now - by invoking the Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms' little-used "notwithstanding clause," which allows Parliament to override a court ruling. We need to urge Parliament to invoke the "notwithstanding clause" and craft a law that will protect vulnerable Canadians from this ruling. It should be noted that in 2010 MPs overwhelmingly rejected a proposal to legalize euthanasia in 2010 by a vote of 228 to 59.
